### **ELIGIBILITY**

- Original work or work previously shared
- Primary author must have participated in the activities showcased and obtained the necessary approvals where sensitive data is used
- Published papers; pre-prints; or completed / very late-stage research that is ready to be presented
- Research ongoing or completed and author should present data / outcomes
- Preference given to recent scholarship and research
- No more than two posters and abstracts per primary author
